

Directions to Local Parks

Abbingtion Drive Park (Twin Rivers)

From Rte 571 East crossover Rte 130. At the light turn left onto Mercer St. At the next light turn right onto Rte 33. At the light after the Mobile station make a right onto Twin Rivers Dr. South and a quick right onto Abbingtion Dr. Make a left into the shopping center and the park is behind the library.

Anker Park (East Windsor)

Located on Hickory Corner Road between the Hickory Corner Library and Dutch Neck Rd. Across from Lee's Turkey Farm.

Community Park at Wood's Road (East Windsor)

Take Rte 130 or Old York Rd (Rte 539) to Conover Rd. Turn onto Woods Rd. (near Centex developments.) The park is less than half a mile on the left.

Cranbury-Millstone Park (Cranbury)

Take Rte 130 North past Town Center Plaza. At the next traffic light make a left onto Old Cranbury Rd. Make a left onto Old Trenton Rd. Park is on the right.

Tantum Park, Meadowbrook Rd. (Robbinsville)

From Rte 130 traveling south, make a right onto Meadowbrook Rd. The park is about a ½ mile up on the right side.

Veteran's Park (Hamilton)

Take Rte 130 south to Kuser Rd. Make a right onto Kuser Rd. (It's right before the entrance to 195.) Go to the first traffic signal and turn right. Go through the next light and the park entrance is on the left, across from Steinert High School. Follow park road to parking lot.

Village Park (Cranbury)

Take Rte 130 North past Town Center Plaza. At the next traffic light make a left onto Old Cranbury Rd. At the stop sign make a left onto North Main Street. Go past the lake and PNC Bank. Turn right onto Park Place. Turn left onto Maplewood Ave. Take the next right into the park.

Washington Twp Park (Robbinsville)

Take Rte 130 South. Make a left on Gordon Rd. (right before National Pools). You will come to a stop sign in about 2-3 miles. Go straight at the stop sign. The park will be up on the right.

West Windsor Community Park (West Windsor)

From Rte 130 turn onto Rte 571 West (Princeton-Hightstown Rd). After McCafferty's grocery store (Southfield Rd) turn right into the park at the second light.
